Official and “unofficial” functions and actions that violate the student code of conduct are still subject to judicial sanctioning by the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution regardless of location. All reports submitted to their office will be fully investigated. Any reports submitted to Fraternity & Sorority Life will be sent to the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution. Any violations of federal and state laws will also be subject to additional judicial action. It will be important to remind your members about university social event policies along with your individual organizational social event policies. If an emergency should arise at any activities, please do not hesitate to call 911 for assistance. Also, be sure to be in communication with your chapter advisor and/or advisory board and be aware of your chapter’s risk management plan.

This notice is not to serve as a warning, but rather it is to serve as a reminder that expectations are set high for members within the FIU Greek community. Our hope is that all members are living up to the values of their organizations and carrying themselves in an appropriate and safe manner during all times.
