

2015 FIU FORMAL RECRUITMENT DISAFFILIATION RULES

Disaffiliation Phase 1 runs from May 8th, 2015 to August 3rd, 2015.

Disaffiliation Phase 2 runs from August 3rd, 2015 to September 20th, 2015.

Please note: the term Recruitment Team Member refers to Rho Gammas and the Panhellenic Executive Board (Pi Chi). All Disaffiliation Phases apply to Rho Gammas, but in accordance with NPC rules and regulations, Disaffiliation Phase 1 is optional for Pi Chi/Rho Alphas/Rho Gamma Educator.

1. Rho Gammas are not to wear any letters and/or affiliated accessories representing their chapter. Effective **Disaffiliation Phase 1**.
2. Rho Gammas will remove any paraphernalia off their cars, office, jewelry, or anything in the view of the public. This includes door of any room on campus and the inside of any room if the Rho Gamma is resident assistant or resident in any residence hall. Effective **Disaffiliation Phase 1**.
3. Rho Gammas will deactivate their Facebook. All online communities such as twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, Vine, and Snapchat must be privatized and the last and first name of the Recruitment Team member must be removed. Effective **Disaffiliation Phase 1**.
4. During **Disaffiliation Phase 1**, Rho Gammas are permitted to socialize with any affiliated woman as long as letters of affiliation are removed. They may not attend chapter meetings, mixers, and other chapter functions. An exception will be made for sisterhood retreats held during the summer. Date must be communicated at least two weeks in advance. Retreats with recruitment components are prohibited.
5. During **Disaffiliation Phase 2**, Recruitment Team Members are not to socialize with any affiliated women, nor are they allowed to attend chapter meetings, mixers, fraternity rush events, or any other chapter functions.
6. During **Disaffiliation Phase 1**, Recruitment Team Members should be discreet about socializing with other affiliated individuals from all greek councils.
7. During **Disaffiliation Phase 2**, Recruitment Team Members are PROHIBITED from having any form of communication (verbal, written, electronic, ect.) with any affiliated chapter member. If an emergency should arise, proper personnel should be notified and the necessary steps will be taken to resolve the situation. If significant other is affiliated we ask for it to be communicated to Panhellenic leadership to prevent misunderstanding.
8. During the dates of **Formal Recruitment**, Recruitment Team members are not permitted to socialize with any affiliated men. They are prohibited from communicating with any affiliated men or women, unless it is a business situation. If significant other is affiliated we ask for it to be communicated to Panhellenic leadership to prevent misunderstanding.
9. On any FIU campus, Rho Gammas are encouraged to engage in positive Panhellenic contact with all affiliated women until the end of **Disaffiliation Phase 1**.
10. Recruitment Team members are not allowed to serve as New Member Educator, Vice President of Membership Recruitment, Pledge Mom, or any associated position. Once **Disaffiliation Phase 2** commences the recruitment team member must relinquish any chair position until after Bid Day.
11. Once a woman has accepted a position of the Recruitment Team, she will be unable to participate in any recruitment activities with her chapter until unveiling on Bid Day. This rule applies to any Recruitment Team member that either chooses or is asked to resign from their responsibilities.
12. Recruitment Team members are not to attend FIU football tailgates.
13. During **Disaffiliation Phase 2** Recruitment Team members are not to attend parties hosted by fraternities or otherwise.
14. During **Disaffiliation Phase 2** Recruitment Team members are not to visit fraternity houses.

I attest I will follow these rules through September 20, 2015 in order to maintain a fair recruitment process for our potential new members. I understand that if I break any of these rules, I will be subject to termination of my position/responsibilities and I will not be able to participate in my chapter's recruitment process.
