10 **Section I: Policy**

11 The proposal outlined in this Council Bill are in compliance with the authority granted in Article

12 III, Section 5.A of the Student Government Association Constitution;

23 **Section III: Bill**

24 WHEREAS, an effective agenda sets clear expectations & structure for what needs to occur

25 before and during a meeting;

26 WHEREAS, an effective agenda allows Senators to prepare, allocate time wisely, quickly get the

27 Assembly on the same topic, and identifies when discussion is complete;

28 WHEREAS, the SGC-MMC Legislative Statues and Senate Rules of Procedure does not have an

29 established agenda order leading to inefficient execution of measures;

66 **Section IV: Enactment**


67 This Bill and all its contents shall be the official law of the SGC-MMC upon passage by the

72 make any prior legislation that conflicts with this legislation hereby null and void;

73 Upon the passage and approval of this council bill, the contents of the it shall be made
74 incorporated into the SGC-MMC Statutes and those provisions of the SGC-MMC Statutes which
75 contradict this council bill shall be made null and void.



